Igor S. Ivanov worked as a researcher at the Institute of World Economy and International Relations (IMEMO), the Academy of Sciences of USSR

From 1991 to 1993, he represented the USSR and then Russia as Ambassador to Spain.

He served as Minister of Foreign Affairs, from 1998 to 2004, and Secretary of the Security Council of the Russian Federation, from 2004 to 2007.
