


Juha Jokela

Juha Jokela is the Programme Director of the European Union research programme at the Finnish Institute of International Affairs (FIIA).

He was a Senior Visiting Research Fellow at the European Union Institute for Security Studies from September 2009 to March 2010. Prior to this he was advisor at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland (2009), and Director of the University of Helsinki Network for European Studies (2008). At the FIIA, his research focuses on the role of the G-20 in global governance, regionalism and the EU's relations with Asia.

His previous publications and research projects include *The Role of the European Union in Asia: China and India as Strategic Partners* (Ashgate, 2009 – co-edited with Bart Gaens and Eija Limnell), *Europeanization and Foreign Policy: State Identity in Finland and Britain* (Routledge, 2010) and *The G-20: A pathway to effective multilateralism?* (EUISS, 2011).
