He was also the Director of the Trade and Regional Integration Division (2003-2006) and the Director of ECA's Office in Central Africa (2001-2003). He holds a PhD in International Economics from the University of Grenoble, France. He also holds a HDR (Habilitation à Diriger la Recherche) from the same university. He taught international economics and development economics in several universities and published extensively books, reports, articles and chronicles. He has written several books including:
