He joined the French natural gas monopoly Gaz de France for 20 years and ended as head of the Financial and Treasury Department.

Retired in 2003, he founded Altergaz, first and main competition to Gaz de France Suez in the newly opened French market of natural gas. The Company was sold end of 2010 to E.N.I to match the ambition of challenging G.D.F. Suez in the French market.
