Chairman and CEO, Convictions AM



An actuary by training and an I.S.F.A. (Lyon) graduate, Philippe Delienne is widely recognized as a financial and asset management professional.

He began his career at Caisse Centrale des Banques Populaires in 1972. In 1974, he joined Crédit Agricole, where he remained until 1987. He was the Head of the Fixed Income department, then he took the responsibility of the Bond group. After a stay in the U.S. (Chicago) as Vice President at Crédit Agricole, he headed the Treasury department of the Caisse Nationale du Credit Agricole up in 1987. From 1988 to 1999, while Vice President and Chief Executive Officer of Banque CPR, and Chairman of CPR Gestion, he founded the first French online broker: CPR Bourse, which became CPR e*Trade. In 2000, he co-founded La Française des Placements. Then, in 2003, to respond to investors' expectations with regards to asset management, he created the Convictions Premium Fund. In 2008, he founded with a tight-knit team of professionals a new asset management company: Convictions AM.
