Cullen Hendrix is Assistant Professor of Government at the College of William & Mary and research associate at the Peterson Institute for International Economics, the Robert S. Strauss Center for International Security and Law, and the Centre for the Study of Civil War at the International Peace Research Institute, Oslo (PRIO).

His research interests include environmental security, food security, and transnational activism. He is the cocreator of the Social Conflict in Africa Database (http://www.scaddata.org), a project that monitors and analyzes patterns of conflict in Africa.

In addition to his academic pursuits, he has consulted for the World Food Programme and the Human Security Report Project. He received his PhD in Political Science from the University of California, San Diego.
