Raphael Wittenberg has an MA in politics and philosophy from the University of Oxford and an MSc in economics from the London School of Economics and Political Science. Raphael Wittenberg is a Senior Research Fellow at the Personal Social Services Research Unit (PSSRU) at the London School of Economics and Political Science, where he leads a program of research on financing long-term care and care for older people in the community. He currently leads a multi-site study, funded by the AXA Research Fund, on how private long-term care insurance can supplement state systems in the UK. Raphael Wittenberg is also a Senior Research Fellow at the Centre for Health Service Economics and Organisation (CHSEO) at Nuffield College Oxford, where he leads a comparative study of eligibility criteria for social care in different countries. He has been for many years a Senior Economist at the Department of Health for England. He led until recently a team of analysts providing economic, operational research and statistical advice and analysis for policy-makers and Ministers on social services, mental health services, services for disabled people, child health services and offender health services.
