The Deputy Secretary of the Presidium of the General Council of the All-Russian political party “Yedinaya Rossiya” (“United Russia”)re international politics and interparty relations. The member of the faction “Yedinaya Rossiya” (“United Russia”). The administrator of the deputation of the State Duma in the Delegation of the Federal Council of the Russian Federation in the Council of Europe Parliamentary Assembly, Vice-speaker of PACE. The Member of the Council of the Interparliamentary group of the Russian Federation, the coordinator of the deputy group of the relation with the parliament of the Kingdom of Sweden
