Faisal Bin Abdulrahman Bin Muaammar was appointed Secretary General of Vienna's King Abdullah bin Abdulaziz International Centre for Interreligious and Intercultural Dialogue (KAICIID) in 2012. Prior to this appointment, he held a number of senior positions in the Saudi Arabian administration and various non-profit organisations. Among the highlights of a distinguished career, Mr Muaammar has served as Vice Minister of Education of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Advisor to the Royal Court, and Deputy of the National Guard for Cultural & Educational Affairs.

He continues to work as Advisor to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, King Abdullah Bin Abdulaziz Al Saud; Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees and Secretary General of the King Abdulaziz Center for National Dialogue and Supervisor-General of the King Abdulaziz Public Library, both in Riyadh. Further to this broad portfolio, Mr. Muaammar serves on the Board of Directors of many national and international organisations, including the World Scout Foundation.

Throughout his career, he has been a major advocate of conciliation and cross-cultural collaboration, notably supporting the development of Messengers of Peace, a unique initiative that aggregates inventive solutions and socially orientated schemes run by 30 million scouts.
