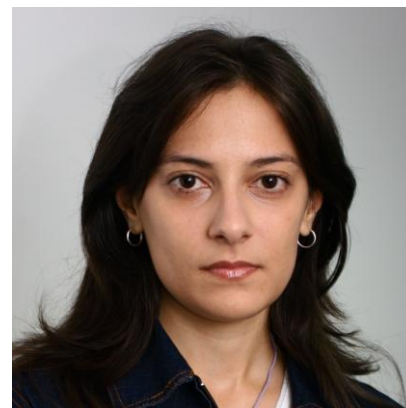


Oana Popescu

Oana Popescu is Director and founder of GlobalFocus, a strategic analysis and foreign policy think-tank. She is also Senior Editor of Foreign Policy (Romanian edition of the international magazine), a frequent TV commentator on global affairs and guest lecturer with the Romanian National Defence Academy.

Formerly Foreign Affairs Adviser to the President of the Romanian Senate, Programmes Director with the Aspen Institute Romania and before that a journalist, Oana has specialised in emerging threats, democratisation, political transitions and post-conflict reconstruction at Yale University as a Fulbright Scholar, Harvard Kennedy School (USA) and St Andrew's University (UK). She carried out research projects for NATO, the European Council on Foreign Relations (ECFR) and the Swedish Crisis Management Research and Training Institute (CRISMART). She has been interviewed by and has been a contributor to many European publications, as well as the geopolitical intelligence firm Stratfor in the US. Oana has co-authored and edited several books on crisis management, strategic foreign policy analysis, the healthcare system, religious radicalism, Ukraine, Russia and the former Soviet space.

Oana Popescu is also a business consultant focusing on strategic business development, with a particular interest in emerging markets. Her geographic areas of expertise are primarily North America, the Black Sea region, the Balkans and the Middle East.
