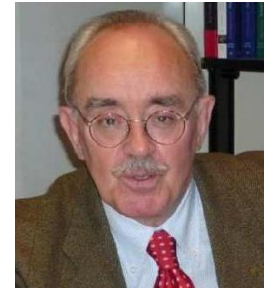


Jean-Yves Carfantan

Jean-Yves Carfantan is a Senior Consultant and runs AgroBrasConsult, a Brazilian consulting company located in São Paulo and Rio de Janeiro.

After being a Cooperating Professor at the University of Brazzaville (Congo) from 1975 to 1978, Jean-Yves Carfantan became a Professor of International Economics at the Institut Supérieur de Gestion (ISG) in Paris, and later he was Professor in Agricultural Economics at the Ecole Supérieure d'Agriculture d'Angers (France). He has been responsible for initiating and managing partnerships with five Brazilian universities.

Jean-Yves Carfantan has lectured at several Brazilian universities and consulted to a range of organizations of cooperatives in Brazil, the grains sector's research department, Céleres as well as with Banco do Brasil, the main financing institution of Brazilian agriculture. He has led and conducted studies on the fertilizer industry and the soybean supply-chain.

Jean-Yves Carfantan is the author of ten books, latest in 2009 *Le choc alimentaire mondial (The Global Food Shock)*. Since 1997, Jean-Yves Carfantan is a member of the Fernand Braudel Institute of São Paulo.

Since 1994, he has been the correspondent in Brazil of the Cercle Cyclope, group set up and coordinated by Professor Philippe Chalmin.

Resident in Brazil since 2000, Jean-Yves Carfantan was born in France. He graduated in Economics and in Philosophy and holds a postgraduate degree in International Business.
