Dominique David is Advisor to the Executive Chairman, Ifri, Editor of *Politique étrangère* and co-director of the annual report Ramses. He is also President of the Austro-French Centre for Rapprochement in Europe. Former Executive Vice-President of Ifri.

Dominique David has been researcher at the Center of Political Studies of Defense (université de Paris I), Deputy Director of the Institut français de polémologie (French Institute of Polemology), and from 1985 to 1991, Secretary General of the FEDN (Fondation pour les études de défense nationale). He also taught at the Military School of Saint-Cyr (Coëtquidan), at the Paris I University and at the Institut d'études politiques de Paris (IEP).

Researcher at Ifri since 1992, Dominique David has been in charge of the Security Studies department since 2000.

Dominique David has been, from 1998 to 2010, member of the Scientific Council of Defense.
