Mr. Denis Bauchard is consultant in international relations. He is presently Senior Fellow for North Africa/Middle East at the French Institute of International Relations (Ifri) in Paris. He was formerly President of the Arab World Institute located in Paris. Mr. Bauchard was Ambassador of France to Canada (1998–2001) and Ambassador of France to Jordan (1989–1993). Mr. Bauchard was Chief-of-Staff to the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Hervé de Charette (1996–1997) and Assistant Secretary at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, North Africa and the Middle East (1993–1996). He was appointed as Minister Plenipotentiary in 1987, served as Deputy Assistant Secretary at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (1982–1989) and was Financial Counselor at the French Mission to the United Nations (1978–1981).

Mr. Bauchard was Deputy Assistant Secretary, Treasury department at the Ministry of Economy and Finance in 1977; Assistant to the Minister of Economy and Finance, Jean-Pierre Fourcade (1974–1976); and Assistant to the Minister of State for Budget (Jacques Chirac and then Jean Taittinger) from 1970 to 1973. Mr. Bauchard was also Financial Attaché for the Near and Middle East at the Embassy of France in Lebanon (1966–1970) and Civil Administrator at the Ministry of Finance (1964–1966). Mr. Bauchard graduated from Paris Institute of Political Studies. He holds a BA degree in Economics. He also attended the École Nationale d'Administration (National School of Administration).

He published or edited several books – « La démocratie est-elle soluble dans l'Islam ? » CNRS, 2007 - and write in different papers (Le Monde, Politique Étrangère) or websites (Ifri).
