In addition, Vice-President Ryszard Czarnecki is a member of the Delegation DCAS (EU - Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Uzbekistan , Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Mongolia) and the Commission to corporations of parliamentary relations between Turkmenistan and Mongolia. He was awarded high state awards by Ukraine, Georgia and Armenia. He holds a Doctor Honoris Causa of the University in Erevan. Author of 6 books.
