She began her career at the French Sénat, where she served at the Finances and Budget Commission for several years, between 1984 and 1995 and again between 1997 and 2002, auditing a number of public expenditures, notably in the defence, foreign affairs, development, environment, research, education, and media sectors.

She graduated from Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris and holds a degree (DEA) in applied economics.
