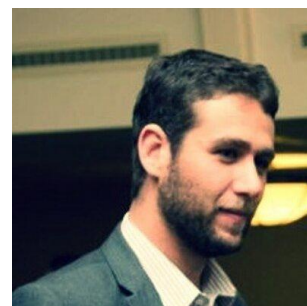


Ryan Evans

Founder, CEO, and editor-in-chief of War on the Rocks



Ryan Evans is the founder, CEO, and editor-in-chief of War on the Rocks, a digital outlet on strategy, defense, and foreign affairs that features the writing of a number of current and former military personnel. He is a widely published commentator and recovering academic. He has written for *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times*, *Studies in Conflict & Terrorism*, the *CTC Sentinel* of West Point, and - of course - *War on the Rocks*. Ryan deployed to Helmand Province, Afghanistan from 2010 – 2011 as a civilian social scientist on a U.S. Army Human Terrain Team that was embedded with the British-led Task Force Helmand. He worked as assistant director at the Center for the National Interest, as a research fellow at the Center for National Policy, and for the International Centre for the Study of Radicalisation and Political Violence in London. Ryan has lectured at the U.S. Army War College, American University, Georgetown University, John Hopkins University, the Naval Postgraduate School, and West Point. He received his MA from the King's College London War Studies Department.
