Mohamed Ait-Kadi is currently President of the General Council of Agricultural Development. The Council is a high-level policy think tank of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fishery, Rural Development and Forestry in Morocco where he has also served as Secretary General and Director General of the Irrigation Department. He was the chief agricultural negotiator in the free trade agreement between Morocco and the United States.

Mohamed is a member of the Hassan II Academy of Sciences and Technology and Professor at the Institute of Agronomy and Veterinary Medicine Hassan II. He is also a member of the Academy of Agriculture of France, Oslo International Water Academy and the International Advisory Panel of the Bioeconomy World Summit.

He served as a member of the Gulbenkian Think Tank on Water and the Future of Humanity, the CGIAR Consortium Board and the Board of Trustees of the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI, Washington). Ait Kadi was chair of the Technical Committee of the Global Water Partnership. He was Governor and founding member of the World Water Council.

He is honorary vice-president of the International Commission on Irrigation and Drainage (ICID).

He has authored numerous publications in the fields of irrigation, water management, and agriculture and rural development.
