Mr. Mohamed METHQAL was appointed by His Majesty the King Mohammed VI on June,23rd 2016 as Ambassador General Director of the Morocco International Cooperation Agency (AMCI).

Prior to his appointment, M. Methqal was during three years the special economic advisor to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, where he was in charge of new economic diplomacy, cooperation and international development. In 2016, he was also the Chief of Staff of the President of COP22. Previously, M. Methqal had been advisor to the Minister of Economy and Finance in Morocco, and had provided consulting and advisory services to Governments, Corporations and Business Leaders since 2004 as he worked in strategy and management consulting at international consulting firms based in Paris. He had also advised companies and investors on strategic projects in Morocco and African countries. M. Methqal began his career in 2000 as a research assistant for three years at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne. M. Methqal co-founded two innovative start-ups and is a winner of the 2003 NETS Prize, awarded to the 15 most promising young entrepreneurs in Switzerland. He has an engineer diploma from the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne (EPFL). He holds an MBA from College des Ingénieurs in Paris and a Certificate in Entrepreneurship from Babson College, USA.
