Mouna Cherkaoui, is Professor of Economics at the University Mohamed V, Faculty of Law, Economics and Social Sciences in Rabat Agdal since 1989. Mouna Cherkaoui holds a Masters and a PHD in Economics with a specialization in international trade and finance obtained at Arizona State University. She is currently a research fellow at the Economic Research Forum (ERF). She has been an elected member in the board of trustees of ERF from 2006 to 2016. She was a member of the Advisory Committee on Economic Research and Policy Analysis on gender (GERPA) of the World Bank. She previously served as an Advisor to the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research. Her research interest includes international economic issues but also issues of poverty and inequality. She has been invited as a teacher and a researcher to many universities such as the University Paris Dauphine, University of Montreal, Duke University and Arizona State University. She conducted research and consultations for various national and international organizations such as the United Nations and the World Bank and coordinated a number of research projects related to international trade, pro-poor growth and migration.
