

Mohamed Tawfik Mouline

Director General of the Royal Institute for Strategic Studies



Mohammed Tawfik MOULINE is the Honorary President of the Moroccan Association of Regional Science, and a member of various scientific committees. Since graduating from the Paris Polytechnic School and obtaining a degree from the Paris Mining School, MOULINE has gone on to have influential roles in a variety of institutions. As a member of the Prime Minister cabinet, he worked on public sector assessments and the reform report about the pricing of public goods and services. MOULINE was, successively, a Director in different areas of the ONA Group (SNI currently), including Studies and Development, Financial Sector, and Telecommunication and Information System Pole: he conducted large scale investment projects and designed a global financial strategy, while completing many studies and contributing to the improvement of the Group's financial sector. MOULINE was a Director of Studies and Financial Forecasts at the Ministry of Economy and Finances between 1995 and 2003, followed by a nomination at the Royal Cabinet as in Charge of Mission. Among his other noted accomplishments are receiving the French Legion of Merit by Decree of the President of the Republic of France, chairing the Moroccan Foresight Association, and being a member of the editorial committee of the 50 Years of Human Development report. Since being appointed as a Director General of the Royal Institute for Strategic Studies, he directs the institution's multi-dimensional work on diplomacy and Moroccan foreign affairs, while being a published author in national and international academic journals.
