Prior to his appointment, during three years M. Methqal was the special advisor to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation. He was also the Chief of Staff of the President of COP22. Previously, M. Methqal had been advisor to the Minister of Economy and Finance in Morocco, and had provided consulting and advisory services to Governments, Corporations and Business Leaders since 2004 as he worked in strategy and management consulting at international consulting firms based in Paris. He had also advised companies and investors on strategic projects in Morocco and African countries.

M. Methqal began his career in 2000 as a research assistant for three years at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne.

He has an engineering diploma from the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Lausanne (EPFL) and holds an MBA from College des Ingénieurs in Paris and a Certificate in Entrepreneurship from Babson College, USA.
