He also earned a Doctorate of State in African Studies from the same University in 2002, where he focused on Contemporary West Africa, in 2003 he became Professor of History and Political Anthropology at the Institute of African Studies, Mohammed V University, in 2014, Associate Fellow at the Royal Institute for Strategic Studies Rabat Morocco, and consultant on African and Middle East issue and strategic studies for national and international institution, Moroccan and foreign media. He is currently a professor of Master's Saharan Studies, as well as a doctoral supervisor at the Mohammed V University and Director of Africa and Middle East Centre Studies.
