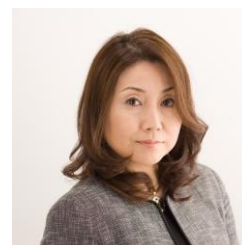


Chiyuki Aoi

Chiyuki Aoi, Ph.D, is Professor of International Security at the Graduate School of Public Policy, the University of Tokyo. Aoi was educated at Sophia University (BA), the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MS), and Columbia University (PhD). From 2008 to 2009, she was Visiting Research Fellow at the Department of War Studies, King's College London. She is currently Visiting Professor there (until March 2020). In August 2018, she was elected a member of the Shinzo Abe administration Council on Security and Defense Capabilities.

Her main research interest is the transformation of warfare, especially with regard to technology and information/strategic communications, counterinsurgency history and theory (British and American), use of force in the post-Cold War era, and Japanese national defence and strategy.

She has published books and journal articles in both English and Japanese, including in *Defence Strategic Communications*, *Pacific Review*, *RUSI Journal*, *Journal of International Peacekeeping*, *International Affairs* (in Japanese) and *Journal of Military History* (in Japanese).
