Member emeritus of the French Conseil d'État, he is the owner of JLG Strategy, an aerospace and defense consultancy company, and a senior lecturer at Sciences-Po Paris, teaching a course on "The new strategic upheaval". Jean-Louis Gergorin has held numerous executive positions such as: Executive Vice-President and member of the Executive Committee of EADS (renamed Airbus), Member of the Executive Committee of Lagardère, Director of Policy Planning of the French Foreign Ministry.

Gergorin graduated from the Ecole Polytechnique and Ecole Nationale d'Administration. He is also an alumnus of the Defense Management Systems Center Program at the US Navy Postgraduate School and of the Stanford Executive Program at Stanford Business School. He has also been a research Fellow at the RAND Corporation and the Harvard Kennedy School. He is a former Trustee and member of the Council of the International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS). He is an active member of the RAND Business Leaders Forum.
