Farid El Bacha is a university professor at the faculty of law in Rabat.

From July 1991 until July 2001, he was a counselor for the General Secretariat of the National Council of Youth and the Future. He is the founder and president of the Moroccan Center for Legal Studies (CMEJ) created in 1996. He is also the founder of the Moroccan Legal Institute which organizes, every year, the francophone legal reading prize; a prize included in the official program for the celebration of the International Day of Francophony, organized by the Ministry of Foreign affairs and Cooperation of Morocco, the Group of Francophone Embassies and the Maghreb bureau in the Francophony Agency.

Executive Chairman of the Center for Studies and Research in Hebrew Law in Morocco, created in Essaouira, Professor EL BACHA discusses the experience of rabbinic courts in Morocco and the contemporary encounter between Muslim law and Hebrew law.

Author of numerous articles on business law, he participated as a contributor to the preparation of the Fiftieth Anniversary Report (Governance and Participatory Development - Report on the Development of a Legal Framework for Human Development and Reform Processes related to the encouragement of general and human development in particular).

President-delegate of the Ribat Al Fath Association for sustainable development, (recognized by public utility) Professor EL BACHA ensures the preparation of national and international scientific meetings, including that organized annually on Morocco-Europe relations in partnership with the Konrad Adenauer Foundation.
