

Achraf Ibrahim

Ambassador of the Republic of Egypt to Morocco



Achraf Ibrahim is a Master's Graduate in Economy and Political Science from the University of Cairo. He's also a graduate of the International Institute of Public Administration in Paris and has an In-Depth Degree in International Trade from Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne University.

He started as a secretary at the Egyptian Embassy and Paris, then became member of the negotiating delegation of the EU-Egypt partnership agreement. He then became Deputy Chief of Mission at the Egyptian Embassy in Kenya. He held, for a short time, the responsibility of Adviser of the Minister of International Cooperation and then Director of the Euro-Mediterranean Partnership Unit.

He moved to Warsaw where he was Deputy Head of Mission at the Egyptian Embassy before becoming Deputy Permanent Representative of Egypt to the Arab League. Achraf Ibrahim was appointed Ambassador of Egypt in the Democratic Republic of Congo to then become Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs for International Economic Affairs. He was the Personal Representative of the Chair to the NEPAD Steering Committee, the National Focal Point to the African Peer Review Mechanism (APRM).

Since 2017, Achraf Ibrahim is the Ambassador of the Republic of Egypt in Morocco.
