He is specialized in the management of conflict situations, and in particular in the management of post-traumatic syndromes, and he has worked with the general doctor Louis Crocq, general doctor of the armed forces who opened the first consultations for victims of psychological trauma (Saint -Antoine in 1987 and Necker Hospital in 1997).

He studies narcoanalysis. He participates in work on sleep, biological rhythms, and physiological and psychological adaptation factors.

He has an analytical, phenomenological, and behavioral training.

In 1996, he published "La Psycho-Stratégie" (Polytechniques Editions).

He has been practicing in Paris for 37 years, with an involvement in corporate work. He has carried out numerous consulting missions and interventions in crisis situations.

Between 1986 and 1997, he maintained regular institutional collaboration with IMS Health (Statistical Medical Institute) as well as with the General Management of Manpower between 1986 and 2002.

From 1992 to 2004, he collaborated with Jean Losi at Progress, a company specializing in consulting and direct approach recruitment, offering several strategies in the field of executive recruitment.

He carried out missions with Danone, Rians, Laboratoires Debat, Spie Batignolles, L'Oréal, EDF, Normédic (Canada), La Poste, and with the government of Senegal from 2000 to 2012.

He has been a member of the Supervisory Board of Edeis since 2017.
