General Francis A. BEHANZIN, an Ecowas citizen coming from Benin Republic holds a Masters in Law and Political Sciences obtained in 1981 from the National University of Benin.

After several military trainings (Infantry Officer) and then police trainings (Police Commissioner Diploma) realized in Benin, Cameroon and France and Nigeria, he has served in particular in Benin's Security and Defense Forces at the following positions:

- ✓ Technical Security Advisor to Honorable Minister of Interior.
- ✓ Director of the Service of Official Trips and the Security of Very High Personalities

At international levels, He has been :

As Commissioner for Political Affairs, Peace and Security of ECOWAS, General Francis A. BEHANZIN has notably managed with great efficiency and discernment political affairs, promotion of democratic governance, and peace in West African region specifically through:

- Preventive diplomacy;
- Election observations;
- Fact-finding missions;
- Pre and Post-electoral conflicts and;
- Mediations in the 15 countries of the West African Region.

Globally, He has notably managed 14 presidential elections, 2 senatorial elections and 4 sensitive parliamentary elections in the region.

On regional security issues, General BEHANZIN has methodically and rationally led the development of the 2020-2024 regional action plan to combat terrorism. In an intelligent strategic approach, he was able, in a multidimensional approach, to bring together all the various actors likely to contribute to stem or even eradicate terrorism in the West African region, namely:

- All the Chiefs of Defence Staff of the 15 member states extended to Chad and Mauritania;
- All the Heads of National Intelligence Agencies of the countries concerned;
- All the Directors General or General Inspector of National Police, Gendarmerie and Security Services;
- Traditional Chiefs, Religious Chiefs of all persuasions together with
- Young people, women and other civil society actors.;
- Military Quatermasters, Logisticians and Heads of Army and Police operations to assess the various programs proposed in above action plan and the approaches to their implementations.

In the same vein and prior to this plan, General BEHANZIN was able to launch the Project entitled WAPIS (Police Information System in West Africa) piloted by INTERPOL with funding from the European Union and intended for the sharing of criminal intelligence in the region enlarged to Mauritania and Chad.

As honorific distinctions, General Francis BEHANZIN is also :

- Commander of the National Order of Benin Republic,
- Knight of the Order of Merit of Benin,
- Medal of Honor of the National Police of Benin,
- Medal of Honor in the Order of Merit of the National Union of Combatants of France,
- Officer of the National Order of Recognition of Guinea Bissau,
- Peace Ambassador of the Universal Federation for World Peace,

General Francis A. BEHANZIN has also obtained several testimonies of recognition of professional skills at national and international levels and especially from the Holy See (VATICAN) for having organized and provided (twice) in Benin, the security of Pope John Paul 2 in March 1993 and of Pope Benedict 16 in November 2011.
